

At the Federation of Bishop Sutton and Stanton Drew Primary Schools, we actively teach British values and promote these in all aspects of our school life. Alongside these, we focus on our school's values which flow from our vision and are the habits and practices we seek to exemplify in all adults and children at both schools. We are committed to fostering a community where our three core values: **Respect, Resilience, and Reflection** guide our actions and learning.

- **Respect:** We value each other's ideas, backgrounds, and differences, creating an inclusive and supportive environment where everyone feels heard and valued.
- **Resilience:** We embrace challenges with a growth mindset, persevering through difficulties and learning from setbacks to achieve our full potential.
- **Reflection:** We take time to consider our actions and learning, using self-awareness to grow, improve, and make positive contributions to our school and beyond.

Through teaching and modelling these values, we empower our students to become responsible, thoughtful, and confident individuals, ready to make a meaningful impact in the world.

These values are taught as part of our curriculum and specifically focussed on in assemblies. Both schools focus on Respect in terms 1 and 2, Resilience in terms 3 and 4 and Reflection in terms 5 and 6. Each class then explores a different aspect of our whole school value in depth each term. This allows the children to deepen their understanding of what the value means as well as relate and apply it to their own experiences as they progress through the school.

We strengthen the teaching and application of these values through providing purposeful opportunities for children to lead different activities in school and in the wider community. Examples in school include leading assemblies, having an additional responsibility within the school or a role such as being a mental health ambassador or member of the eco-team. Examples outside of school include connections and work with charities and other organisations.
