BASC

From September 2021, we have a new Breakfast and After School Club (BASC) provider – PH Sports. (PH Sports run BASC in other local schools, and have been running our Maths on the Move programme over the year, as well as providing some additional sports coaching this year).

PH Sports offer a cheaper service than our current provider, and most importantly, they are able to offer a split session for after school bookings. An Update on Covid-19 Arrangements

You will be aware that there are some anticipated changes on July 19th as we move into the next phase of navigating the pandemic. For the last three days of term, we will not be making any changes to our Risk Assessment or other arrangements in school. What we do hope is that as we reach September, we will be able to reinstate more normality and do away with staggered starts, bubbles etc. Guidance for Primary Schools ahead of September is fairly thin at the moment – especially around general isolation requirements and, in the event of a positive case in a school, who will need to isolate if we have no bubbles. More information is anticipated over the next couple of weeks.

Please help us to minimise the risk to our school from Covid-19 by;

- Wearing a facemask that covers your nose and mouth when entering the school site including the school reception
- Only one adult per family coming onto site to drop off or collect children
- Dropping off and collecting your child as quickly as possible
- Keeping your child with you whilst waiting for other children
- Informing the school when your child is absent and the reason for the absence
- Please do not let the children play on the play equipment after school. (Children should not be playing on the equipment anyway; we have also opened the play equipment to designated classes on a weekly basis and need to avoid cross contamination).

helps to keep money going back into activities and resources for the children. We very much look forward to welcoming some new members to the team! Thank you for all your support throughout the year to date!


Other Event
