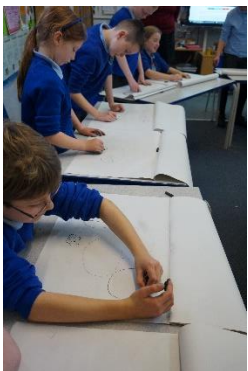

- Meg - I like moving while doing your maths.



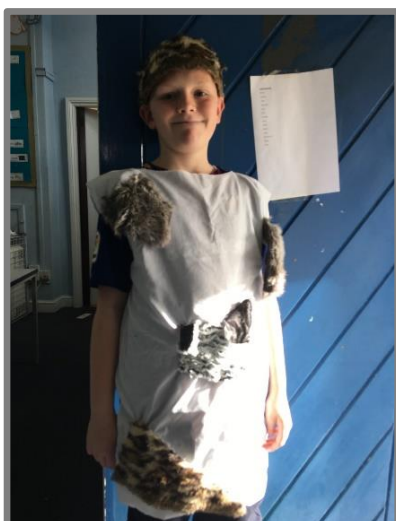
Christmas Meal
