School News

Quick note from Mr Cook:

Following the Government announcement on Monday 10th May we will continue to ask parents to wear face masks when coming onto site or visiting the reception area. We will also continue to ask the same for staff who work across bubbles, as well as for other visitors e.g. therapists, supply staff, peripatetic music teachers etc (whilst recognising the government guidelines on exemptions). We will also continue to ask children and adults to wash hands frequently and continue with the additional cleaning regime that we have in place. We have no updates yet on bubbles and other changes that will affect school organisation e.g. around breaktimes, lunch times, staggered start/finish times.

We also have some tough decisions to make in the next weeks around some of our typical summer activities e.g. Sports Day and the end of year performance; at present, it is still a 'watch this space' brief as we can't be sure what the impact of changes will be and what the future weeks will bring. In the meantime the children will have a mini sports day in their class bubble, led by a member of staff from PH Sports. KS2 events are planned in for this term as below:

Monday 17th May: Wrens Class (Y3) followed by Kingfisher Class (Y6) and

Monday 24th May: Swans Class (Y4) followed by Swallows Class (Y5).

KS1 events will follow in T6 (dates to be finalised - and partly depending on weather conditions for the KS2 classes). Children will need to come to school in their PE kit please and bring water bottles/coats etc.

Help to minimise the Risk

Please help us to minimise the risk to our school from Covid-19 by;

- Wearing a facemask that covers your nose and mouth when entering the school site including the school reception
- Only one adult per family coming onto site to drop off or collect children
- Dropping off and collecting your child as quickly as possible
- Keeping your child with you whilst waiting for other children
- Informing the school when your child is absent and the reason for the absence
- Please do not let the children play on the play equipment after school. (Children should not be playing on the equipment anyway; we have also opened the play equipment to designated classes on a weekly basis and need to avoid cross contamination).

Bikes and Scooters

It is pleasing to see children riding their bikes and scooters to school and parking them in our cycle and scooter racks. Please can we remind parents that children must dismount from their scooter or bike at the school gates and push them to the racks. At the end of the day, they then need to push their bike or scooter to the gates before they ride home. Please do not let your child ride their bike or scooter in the school grounds.
