Update from Mr Cook

I'm so impressed with the way that all children have returned to school at the start of this term; it's been great to see them playing with their friends and working hard on learning activities as well as adapting to the changed routines. Our new safety measures and routines are constantly under review and we will inform you of any changes as they arise. Can I also say thank you to all parents/carers and children for your continued support and understanding.

We will be publishing our Home Learning Offer on the website next week. This sets out what we will aim to provide if we are faced with the decision of closing a bubble or in the event of a local/national lockdown, or if children need to isolate. All classes should now be set up on Clasdojo (or Tapestry for children in Ducklings). Please use this to message teachers etc. If you would like to speak to the teacher please let the office know or send a message on Clasdojo/Tapestry. It's extremely helpful if the teacher knows the nature of your query beforehand and this can often save time for both teachers and parents. We will also be continuing our work on using MS Teams this term in the event that we have to close a bubble or the school at some stage in the future.

Our Behaviour Policy has been updated and is available on the school website here <https://www.bishopsuttonstantondrew.co.uk/Key-Policies/> The main change is the simplification of the rules to one single rule 'We always do our best to be kind, be safe and be responsible'.

If it is your child's birthday, please do not send them in with sweets. We provide a cake bar on the Friday after the child's birthday to celebrate their birthday, and whilst we are not using the library in the conventional sense at the moment, we always welcome 'Birthday Books' to add to our book collection. Nuts in School

Just to remind everyone that **we are a nut-free school**. Please do not send your child into school with any foods that contain nuts, this includes cereal bars and spread such as Nutella. We have children in school who have severe nut allergies and we are sure that you will want to help us to keep them safe.

Crossing Patrol

Mrs Penney our lollipop person has asked the school to remind parents of the correct way to use the crossing patrol.

- At the drop in the pavement wait.
- When it is safe, Mrs Penney will walk to the middle of the road with her lollipop.
- She will then tell you when it is safe to cross.
- Please do not cross behind her or follow her out into the road.

We rely on parents to model using the crossing correctly for the children.

Flu Immunisations

On Wednesday 21st October, the Flu Immunisation Team is coming into school to immunise the children whose parents have requested it. A separate email has been sent with the link to apply for your child to have the vaccine. If you do not apply, your child will not be given the immunisation.

Visits for Reception 2021

Instead of our usual Open Day this year, we are offering socially distanced visits outside of the school day. These are for prospective parents of Reception 2021 only. The visit will include a look around the outside of the school and a chance to ask questions. Only one adult per family can sign up and we are limiting the group size to four people at a time. A facemask must be worn on the school site. No children will be allowed on site for these visits.

We are sorry if this seems stringent but we are trying to minimise risk.

COVID-19 information

A quick guide for parents and carers



Please follow the advice in this guide. Only contact the school if your child is having a test and to let us know the result. Your school will not be able to advise beyond the information given here. **Please remember to only get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms.**

YOU SHOULD BOOK A **TEST** IF YOUR CHILD HAS:

a high temperature

OR

a new continuous cough

OR

a loss of or change to your sense of smell or taste



This means they feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure their temperature)







This means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough it may be worse than usual)

This means they've noticed they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child DOES NOT have symptoms of COVID-19 but has other cold-like symptoms, such as a runny nose, they do not need to be tested and they or members of your household do not need to self-isolate.
