The art installation is to celebrate Earth Week, and bringing attention to environmental and recycling issues. The children used plastic bottles to create flowers, by cutting and shaping the top of the bottle into petals. They then painted these plastic flowers using acrylic paints. Some of them even created extra plastic stems to stick inside the petals. Then, we used the remainder of the bottles to create the trunk of the tree, which they then painted differing shades of brown. We used garden wire to attach the flowers and the trunk to the chicken wire, which was then attached to the school fence. The children worked enormously hard and the rainbow contrast between the different colour hues for each different year group makes the tree look fantastic. We are considering making some more, seeing as they look so colourful and beautiful.


Meerkats wrote thank you letters to The Friends for their new equipment and toys. Here are some of them ..



The Friends are looking into joining this school lottery:



You can either set up a monthly recurring payment plan via Direct Debit or payment card or pay for a block of 1, 3, 6 or 12 months of weekly tickets on a non-recurring basis.

There is no commitment to stay in the lottery and players can choose to leave at any time.

The draw takes place every Saturday, winners will be notified via email. Match all 6 numbers and you win the JACKPOT!

The school will receive 40% of all ticket sales, 36% is used for prizes and 24% is admin fees + VAT.
