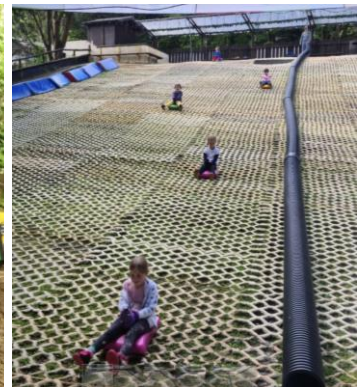
Please note – this Term ends tomorrow, Friday 26th May. We welcome children back to school on Tuesday 6th June following the inset day
