## Attendance Message from Mr Marriott

As part of new government guidance on attendance, I will be regularly reviewing both schools' attendance data to better understand reasons for absence and offer support where appropriate for children and families where attendance drops below 90%. Regular attendance at school is essential for pupils to get the most out of their school experience. The pupils with the highest attainment at the end of key stage 2 have higher rates of attendance over the key stage compared to those with the lowest attainment (DfE Working together to improve school attendance 2022). When a child misses a day or an afternoon for an avoidable reason, it's not just the learning from that session that is lost, they may miss something important for understanding the content in the next lesson they're present.

Positive relationships between home and school are the foundation of good attendance and over the coming months I will aim to communicate clearly, fairly and consistently whenever there is a concern over attendance. As a Federation, we consider over 95% attendance as 'good' and children with attendance of below 90% as persistent absentees, in-line with DfE guidance. Of course, children can't help being ill but it may be that we can support families with a referral to the school nurse or other services if there is a recurring problem affecting both health and schooling.
