Valley Arts

On Friday 7th October, we welcomed professional youth facilitators from Valley Arts, to lead drama-based workshops for some of our pupils in KS1 and KS2 classes. The sessions used fairy tales and storytelling to explore gender stereotypes, while building some simple drama skills. The creative approach aims to increase pupils' confidence, inspire creative thinking, and improve problem solving and presentation skills.

Valley Arts offered these workshops at no cost to the school, thanks to support from Arts Council England, and the sessions were a perfect taster for our pupils ahead of the <u>Valley Arts Fringe</u> <u>Festival</u>. This month-long programme in local venues (4 Nov-4 Dec) offers a brilliant array of high-quality theatre, dance, music and comedy shows for all ages, with lots of free workshops available. Tickets are available via the <u>Valley Arts website</u>, with great early bird savings until 9th October. You can also pick up a Fringe Festival programme from the school reception.

Valley Arts is a local charity that exists to inspire and delight audiences by delivering high quality live performance and participation for the community of the Chew Valley. They work with local schools, artists and organisations to enable people of all ages to be entertained, inspired and supported by the arts. The Valley Arts year-round programme of events, workshops, holiday clubs and their weekly youth theatre, supports the wellbeing of our rural community with a focus on young people and families.

Open Day for Parents of Reception Children Sept 23

Our Second Open Day is on 2nd November, for parents whose children are due to start school in September 2023. If you have or you know of anyone whose child is starting school in September 2023 please telephone the school office to make an appointment to visit. Our visits are split into half hourly slots 9:30, 10:00, 10:30, 11:00 in the morning and 2:00 or 2:30 in the afternoon.

Pupil Absence Request

If you are requesting an absence for your child in term time please remember to fill in the appropriate form (which can be found on our website under policies) and return it to the school office at least two weeks before the absence. Even if you are taking your child out for half a day a form still needs to be completed.

Flu Vaccinations

All children in **Year R to Year 6** from September 2022 are eligible for a free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination. The immunisation team will be visiting our school on Wednesday 2nd November 2022.

Seasonal flu vaccination remains one of the most important public health interventions to protect individuals and prevent the spread of infection to those most at risk in society. This contributes to reduce morbidity, mortality and hospitalisation associated with flu at a time when the NHS and social care will be managing winter pressures, potentially including further outbreaks of COVID-19. For this reason, it is essential we deliver the vaccine to as many children as possible. Full information about this live vaccination, including frequently asked questions and access to the NHS England information, are available when accessing the link. We recommend you discuss this vaccination with your child prior to the date of vaccination.
