


Red Nose Day – Friday 17th March


We will be supporting Comic Relief on Friday 17th March for Red Nose Day. Children may come to school in non-uniform, wearing something red, for a donation to charity.

As part of their English lessons, children in Year 1 and 2 have been writing letters to parents to try to encourage recycling. Here are two examples that we found to be particularly persuasive....





Lemurs

Lemurs class have created a 3D cityscape based around the work of artist Charles Fazzino. The children drew buildings and structures and then made them 3D by projecting them on cardboard stands, thus creating the 3D look.

The children also created a Big Ben collage piece based on the artwork of Leonid Afremov, who uses bright acrylic paints and knives to 'scrape' the paint onto his work. Each child created their own 'tile', which we then combined to create the whole piece.







Place 2 Be – Parenting support notes and films

King Charles - Coronation Project


