Items the people of Ukraine need are changing daily:

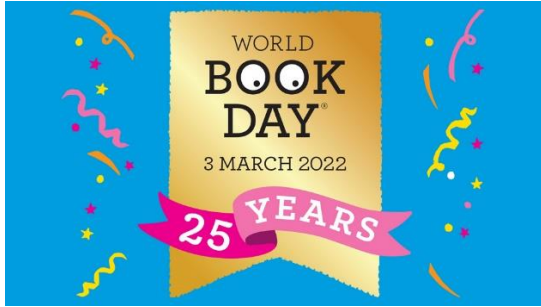
- Torches and Batteries
