## **Parking at Drop Off and Collection**

Please remember to park thoughtfully when dropping off or collecting you child. We have had numerous complaints about parents parking across our neighbours' driveways at the front of the school. We have also had complaints about parking on the pavement at the back of the school. Children and parents are struggling to use the pavement to walk safely home or to their car.

#### Illness and Strep A

We are currently experiencing high levels of illness in both schools and there is understandable concern about the tragic deaths of several children nationally with Strep A infections. Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell or have a high temperature. At both schools we continue to encourage good respiratory and hand hygiene to help prevent the spread of infections.

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) has issued some guidance with regards to Strep A infections and it provides good advice on symptoms and when to seek medical advice. <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/news/ukhsa-update-on-scarlet-fever-and-invasive-group-a-strep">https://www.gov.uk/government/news/ukhsa-update-on-scarlet-fever-and-invasive-group-a-strep</a>.

Scarlet fever is usually a mild illness and it is very rare that the bacteria causes the serious illness called invasive Group A strep (iGAS). However, it is important everyone is aware of symptoms, which include a sore throat, headache, and fever, along with a fine, pinkish or red body rash with a sandpapery feel, and please keep your child(ren) away from school if they are unwell. Please make sure you inform us if your child develops Scarlet fever so we can take steps to control any potential outbreak.
